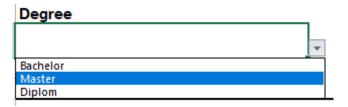
Instruction for the recognition form

Step 1: Fill out the header

First, please fill in the header of the document by entering your first and last name as well as your student number.

The Second line uses drop-down menus. Please select your intended degree, course of study and type of recognition by clicking the small gray arrow in the respective field and then selecting the entry that is applicable to you. Please note that you cannot select the degree program until you have selected the degree.



Step 2: Which module to you want to get recognized

Please indicate which modules you would like to have recognized under "Details on the already completed/planned modules". If you have completed the module at the TUM, please also enter the TUM ID of the module (usually 2 letters and 4-5 numbers, no long lecture numbers).

If you have completed the module outside of Germany, please enter the grade as it appears on the transcript (e.g. "96"). The conversion into the German grading system will be done by us.
