

Abbreviation - Course Types

- V = A **lecture (Vorlesung)** is a course taught by a university lecturer, usually with many students in a larger lecture hall
- UE = An **exercise (Uebung)** is a course for systematic processing of learning materials and training in the subject. The teacher leads the course, sets tasks and leads the discussion. Learners practice skills and methods, work on contributions, present the contributions, discuss and solve tasks.
- S = A **seminar (Seminar)** is a course with a significant proportion of participants to deepen and practice knowledge, skills and methods,
- PR = **Labwork/Practical (Praktikum)** is a research-oriented course with a small group size and a high proportion of the students' own research output. The students learn to deal with research questions in a practical way, to move in laboratories/with machines, to apply scientific methods, to get to know failures and to use them for further projects as well as to present the results in scientific formats. These courses are usually restricted.
- EX = **Field Trip (Exkursion)**, usually restricted
